The Governor and the Seminole Tribe of Florida signed a new Compact on April 23, 2021, with an amendment on May 17, 2021. It was subsequently ratified by the Legislature in Special Session by CS/SB 2-A, which was approved by the Governor on May 25, 2021. The State of Florida began receiving Indian Gaming payments pursuant to the new Compact in October of 2021. The U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia set aside federal approval of the 2021 Compact on November 22, 2021. The Seminole Tribe of Florida continued revenue sharing with the State of Florida through February, 2022, after which time they discontinued all payments. The case is under appeal in the United States Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit. Oral arguments were held on December 14, 2022. It is currently unknown when or if payments from the Seminole Tribe of Florida will resume into state accounts.
