# Revenue Estimating Conference Indian Gaming Revenues <br> October 22, 2013 <br> Executive Summary 

The Revenue Estimating Conference on Indian Gaming revenues met on October 22, 2013 and adopted updated estimates for revenues from Indian Gaming operations for fiscal years 2013-14 through 2021-22. The revenue estimate for Fiscal Year 2013-14 was increased from the July conference because the state received a \$4.3 million true-up payment in August 2013, which was generated from Fiscal Year 2012-13 activity. Pursuant to the Indian Gaming Compact, the Seminole Tribe is required to pay a minimum guaranteed payment or 12 percent of Net Win, whichever is greater. Fiscal Year 2012-13 is the first time that Net Win reached a level where the 12 percent revenue share was greater than the minimum guarantee of $\$ 233$ million.

The Net Win is projected to continue to increase, remaining above the minimum guarantee threshold. It is expected that larger true-up payments will be generated in fiscal years 2013-14 and 2014-15 and will be received in the following fiscal years. In addition, Net Win is expected to exceed $\$ 2$ billion for the first time in Fiscal Year 2013-14, which will trigger a higher revenue sharing rate of 15 percent for the amount between $\$ 2$ billion and $\$ 3$ billion.

The conference used growth rates derived from pari-mutuel slots activity in Florida to estimate Net Win in fiscal years 2013-14 through 2015-16 and then a flat growth rate of 2 percent in fiscal years 2016-17 through 2021-22. Slot Machine tax revenue has exceeded expectations this fiscal year and is expected to continue to grow, which results in higher growth rates for the first three fiscal years than were used in the July forecast.
