# Revenue Estimating Conference <br> Indian Gaming Revenues <br> Executive Summary 

February 5, 2014

The Revenue Estimating Conference met on February 5, 2014, and adopted estimates for Indian Gaming revenues for Fiscal Years 2013-14 through 2022-23. Fiscal Year 2013-14 was the first time the state received a true-up payment, which was generated from Fiscal Year 2012-13 activity. Pursuant to the Indian Gaming Compact, the Seminole Tribe is required to make a minimum guaranteed payment for each of the first five years of the Compact unless 12 percent of Net Win produces a larger amount. The Net Win is projected to continue to increase in the new forecast, remaining above the minimum guarantee threshold. As a result, larger true-up payments than expected at the October 2013 Conference will be generated in fiscal years 2013-14 and 2014-15; those dollars will be received in Fiscal Years 2014-15 and 2015-16. Net Win is expected to exceed $\$ 2$ billion for the first time in Fiscal Year 2013-14, which will trigger a higher revenue sharing rate of 15 percent for the amount between $\$ 2$ billion and $\$ 3$ billion.

For Fiscal Years 2013-14 and 2014-15, the conference adopted higher growth rates than used in the October forecast because recent Indian Gaming quarterly financial reports have indicated much stronger growth in revenues. The conference used growth rates derived from pari-mutuel slots activity in Florida to estimate Net Win in Fiscal Years 2015-16 and 2016-17, and assumed a growth rate of 2 percent each fiscal year thereafter. The stronger growth rates through Fiscal Year 2016-17 will produce greater receipts for the state.
