- (2) If all counties were to implement the increased exemption, the statewide cost in the fifth year would be approximately \$10.7 million, assuming no off-setting changes in millage rates by local governments.
- (3) If the electorate approves the amendment, the statewide impact in 2009-10 would be -\$2.2 billion, assuming no off-setting changes in millage rates by local governments.
- (4) Should the electorate approve the amendment, the tax base statewide would be affected as follows: 2008-09 -\$23,714,209,869, 2009-10 -\$49,654,532,809, 2010-11 -\$76,899,391,350, 2011-12 -\$105,767,494,394, 2012-13 -\$136,647,412,012. Assuming no changes in millage rates, the statewide tax loss would be 2008-09 \$464,798,513, 2009-10 \$973,228,843, 2010-11 \$1,507,228,070, 2011-12 \$2,073,042,890, 2012-13 \$2,678,289,277.
