

Voluntary Prekindergarten Estimating Conference Executive Summary July 31, 2015

The Voluntary Prekindergarten Estimating Conference met on July 31, 2015, to adopt the impact on the VPK program from the expansion of the Personal Learning Scholarships to four year olds; review and analyze updated 2014-15 school year and 2015 summer data reported through June 2015; and adopt a forecast through 2019-20.

The conference decreased the forecasted 2014-15 school year enrollment based on reported school year and summer data through June 2015. This reduction extends into the outer years; however, population growth will continue to drive overall increases in enrollment. This growth only affects school year enrollment, since summer enrollment is forecast to remain at 2015 summer forecasted levels.

The forecast uses the most recent ratio of FTE to enrollment (2014-15 school year and 2014 summer) and includes estimates for the Specialized Instructional Services Program (SISP).

While the new forecast produces a participation rate of roughly 75.0% of all eligible children in all forecast years, the Conference views the recent drift in the percentage as a risk to the forecast.

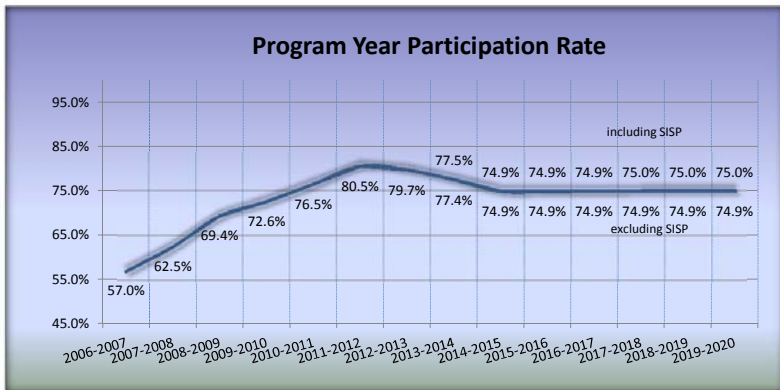
