# Education Estimating Conference on Student Financial Aid EXECUTIVE SUMMARY 

August 1, 2018

The Student Financial Aid Estimating Conference met on August 1, 2018, to review FY 2017-18 projected actual awards and to adopt new estimates for FY 2018-19 through FY 2023-24. The new estimates described below are compared to the Post-Session estimates, which incorporated the law changes and appropriations made during the 2018 Regular Session, and were also approved at this conference.

Bright Futures Scholarships: The projected actual awards for FY 2017-18 were 94,124, an increase of 487 awards (0.5\%) over the Post-Session estimate. In addition, the Conference adopted an estimate of $\mathbf{3 , 1 1 9}$ awards for early summer enrollments of recent high school graduates who are initially eligible for an award in the 2018-19 academic year and enrolled early in the 2018 summer term. The projected numbers may change as summer term awards are finalized. For FY 2018-19, the Conference adopted $\mathbf{9 6 , 2 6 0}$ total awards, an increase of 471 awards ( $0.5 \%$ ) over the Post-Session estimate, due in large part to an expected increase in the number of high school standard graduates. In addition, the Conference adopted an estimate of 6,979 early summer enrollments for the 2019 summer term. For FY 2019-20, the Conference adopted 99,003 total awards, as well as a total of 6,865 early summer enrollments for the 2020 summer term.

Effective Access to Student Education (EASE) Grants: There were 37,899 projected awards for FY 2017-18, a decrease of 31 awards $(0.1 \%$ ) below the Post-Session estimate. For each year of the forecast, the Conference used three-year average annual growth rates for each institution with adjustments made for institutions with unique enrollment patterns. The Conference adopted 39,173 awards for FY 2018-19, an increase of 83 awards ( $0.2 \%$ ) over the Post-Session estimate. For FY 2019-20, the Conference adopted 39,754 awards, an increase of 299 awards ( $0.8 \%$ ) over the Post-Session estimate.

Access to Better Learning and Education Grants (ABLE): There were 2,733 total projected awards for FY 2017-18, an increase of 80 awards (3.0\%) over the Post-Session estimate. The Conference adopted 1,960 awards for FY 2018-19, an increase of 149 awards ( $8.2 \%$ ) over the Post-Session estimate. For FY 2019-20, the Conference adopted $\mathbf{1 , 9 4 8}$ awards, an increase of 160 awards ( $8.9 \%$ ) over the Post-Session estimate. The increases to the estimates for FY 2018-19 and FY 2019-20 are primarily related to the addition of one new eligible institution.

Florida Student Assistance Grants (FSAG): There were a projected 194,867 total awards in FY 2017-18. Although this was a decrease of 39,957 awards from the Post-Session estimate, an additional 72,359 awards were provided than in the previous year. For each year of the forecast, the Conference assumed an increase in total expenditures equivalent to Florida population growth and a redistribution of funds among the four programs to fund additional otherwise eligible students. These assumptions resulted in estimated awards of 195,295 for FY 2018-19 and 198,346 for FY 2019-20.

Children/Spouses of Deceased/Disabled Veterans (CSDDV): For FY 2017-18, there were 1,427 projected actual awards, a decrease of 12 awards ( $0.8 \%$ ) from the Post-Session estimate. For FY 2018-19, the Conference adopted 1,538 awards, a decrease of 60 awards ( $3.8 \%$ ) from the Post-Session estimate. The reduction to the estimate is related to a change in the veteran certification process that affected initial awards for FY 2018-19 but is expected to be resolved by the 2019-20 fiscal year. For FY 2019-20, the Conference adopted 1,693 projected awards, a decrease of 54 awards ( $3.1 \%$ ) from the Post-Session estimate. This reduction is a spillover effect from the lower initial awards forecast in FY 2018-19, which resulted in a lower number of renewal awards in 2019-20. The estimated number of initial awards for FY 2019-20 matched the Post-Session estimate at 755 awards.

Benacquisto Scholarship Program: There were 928 projected awards for FY 2017-18, an increase of 9 awards (1.0\%) over the Post-Session estimate. For each year of the forecast, the Conference maintained the previous estimates for the number of initial awards for Florida residents and averaged the two forecasts for renewal awards for Florida residents due to uncertainty regarding fifth year renewal rates. For nonresident students, the

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higher forecast was adopted to account for increased interest in the program by out-of-state students. These assumptions resulted in 1,133 projected awards for FY 2018-19 (increase of 30 awards or $2.7 \%$ ) and 1,314 projected awards for FY 2019-20 (increase of 84 awards or 6.8\%).

Florida Farmworker Scholarship Program: The Conference maintained the Post-Session estimates for this new program, which assumed the maximum allowable 50 awards would be awarded each year of the forecast.

The adopted estimates for each program are shown in the table below. Across all programs, including the Bright Futures early summer enrollments, the Conference anticipates 342,387 awards in FY 2018-19 and 348,973 awards in FY 2019-20.
