#### Education Estimating Conference on Student Financial Aid EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

#### March 15th Revision

The Student Financial Aid Estimating Conference met on March 15, 2019, to revise the estimates that were adopted on March 6, 2019, for the Effective Access to Student Education (EASE) Grant Program. The Conference adopted a new forecast that incorporates students on the waiting list into the estimates. Compared to the previous forecast, all of the estimated increases are associated with wait list students and assume similar enrollment patterns in future years. For FY 2018-19, the Conference projects there will be **39,415** awards, an increase of 220 awards (0.6%) over the previous estimate. For FY 2019-20, the Conference adopted an estimate of **40,096** awards, an increase of 307 awards (0.8%) over the previous estimate. No changes were made to the estimates adopted on March 6, 2019, for the other student financial aid programs.

#### March 6, 2019 Estimating Conference

The Student Financial Aid Estimating Conference met on March 6, 2019, to revise the estimates for FY 2018-19 through FY 2023-24 for student financial aid programs.

<u>Bright Futures Scholarships</u>: For FY 2018-19, the Conference projects that there will be **101,291** awards, an increase of 1,808 awards (1.8%) over the previous estimate. The increase is related primarily to more renewal awards than originally expected (an increase of 1,595 awards). For FY 2019-20, the Conference adopted **106,329** total awards, an increase of 2,825 awards (2.7%) over the previous estimate. In addition, the Conference adopted estimates for early summer enrollments, including **7,053** for the 2019 summer term and **7,573** for the 2020 summer term. While the new forecast takes account of the changes that led to the FY 2018-19 growth over the prior year, the Conference did not assume that there would be any additional behavioral changes beyond these. Because of this, there is a high risk associated with this forecast.

<u>Effective Access to Student Education (EASE) Grants</u>: The Conference maintained the current estimates for this program, including an estimated **39,195** awards for FY 2018-19 and **39,789** awards for FY 2019-20. The Conference authorized staff to adjust the adopted estimates should any of the currently eligible institutions become ineligible to participate in the program. Further, the principals requested a follow-up conference (to be scheduled at a future date) to review estimates for any eligible students currently on the wait list.

Access to Better Learning and Education Grants (ABLE): The Conference adopted an estimate of **1,730** awards for FY 2018-19, a decrease of 76 awards (4.2%) from the November estimate. For FY 2019-20, the Conference adopted **1,741** awards, a decrease of 68 awards (3.8%) from the previous estimate.

<u>Florida Student Assistance Grants (FSAG)</u>: The Conference maintained the current estimates for this program, including an estimated **195,468** total awards in FY 2018-19 and **195,648** awards in FY 2019-20.

<u>Children/Spouses of Deceased/Disabled Veterans (CSDDV)</u>: The Conference adopted an estimate of **1,702** awards for FY 2018-19, which is an increase of 57 awards (3.5%) over the November estimate. For FY 2019-20, the Conference adopted **1,862** projected awards, an increase of 95 awards (5.4%) over the previous estimate.

<u>Benacquisto Scholarship Program</u>: The Conference adopted an estimate of **1,147** awards for FY 2018-19, an increase of 11 awards (1.0%) over the November estimate. For FY 2019-20, the Conference adopted **1,416** projected awards, an increase of 12 awards (0.8%) over the previous estimate.

# Education Estimating Conference on Student Financial Aid EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

<u>Florida Farmworker Scholarship Program</u>: The Conference maintained the current estimates of **3** projected awards for FY 2018-19 and the maximum allowable **50** awards for FY 2019-20.

The estimates adopted on March 6, as revised on March 15, are shown in the following table. Across all programs, including Bright Futures early summer enrollments, the Conference anticipates **347,809** awards in FY 2018-19 and **354,715** awards in FY 2019-20. These award levels are higher than expected in November—by 2,572 in the current year and 3,170 in the following year, with nearly all of the change related to Bright Futures.
