Education Estimating Conference on Student Financial Aid EXECUTIVE SUMMARY August 12, 2019

The Student Financial Aid Estimating Conference met on August 12, 2019, to review FY 2018-19 estimated awards and to adopt new projections for FY 2019-20 through FY 2024-25. The new estimates reflect data through July 30, 2019, and are compared to the Post-Session estimates, which incorporated the law changes and appropriations made during the 2019 Regular Session.

<u>Bright Futures Scholarships</u>: The projected actual awards for FY 2018-19 were **101,931**, an increase of 640 awards (0.6%) over the Post-Session estimate. The majority of the increase is related to more renewal awards than originally expected (an increase of 356 awards). In addition, the Conference adopted an estimate of **7,053** awards for early summer enrollments of recent high school graduates who are initially eligible for an award in the 2019-20 academic year and enrolled early in the 2019 summer term. The early summer estimates were unchanged from the prior conference and may change as summer term awards are finalized. For FY 2019-20, the Conference adopted **107,843** total awards, an increase of 1,514 awards (1.4%) over the previous estimate, as well as a total of **7,573** early summer enrollments for the 2020 summer term. For FY 2020-21, the Conference adopted **110,470** total awards, as well as a total of **7,582** early summer enrollments for the 2021 summer term.

<u>Effective Access to Student Education (EASE) Grants</u>: The Conference estimated that the total number of awards would be lower than the previous estimate in all years of the forecast. There were **39,179** projected awards for FY 2018-19, a decrease of 236 awards (-0.6%) relative to the previous estimate. For FY 2019-20, the Conference adopted **39,769** total awards, a decrease of 327 awards (-0.8%) relative to the previous estimate. For FY 2020-21, the Conference adopted **40,657** total awards, a decrease of 460 awards (-1.1%) relative to the previous estimate.

Access to Better Learning and Education (ABLE) Grants: The Conference estimated that the total number of awards would be slightly lower than the previous estimate during the next few forecasted years. The Conference adopted an estimate of 1,722 awards for FY 2018-19, a decrease of 8 awards (-0.5%) from the Post-Session estimate. For FY 2019-20, the Conference adopted 1,735 awards, a decrease of 6 awards (-0.4%) from the previous estimate. The Conference also adopted 1,723 total awards for FY 2020-21, a decrease of 26 awards (-1.5%) relative to the previous estimate.

<u>Florida Student Assistance Grants (FSAG)</u>: The Conference estimated that the total number of awards would be reduced by at least 12,000 awards relative to Post-Session estimates in all years of the forecast. There were **182,657** estimated awards in FY 2018-19, which is a decrease of 12,811 awards (-6.6%) from the Post-Session estimate, although virtually all of the appropriation was expended. For FY 2019-20, the Conference adopted **183,373** awards, a decrease of 12,276 awards (-6.3%) from the previous estimate. The Conference adopted **183,622** total awards for FY 2020-21, a decrease of 12,316 awards (-6.3%) relative to the previous estimate.

<u>Children/Spouses of Deceased/Disabled Veterans (CSDDV)</u>: The Conference adopted an estimate of **1,684** awards for FY 2018-19, which is a decrease of 18 awards (-1.1%) relative to the Post-Session estimate. The Conference maintained the Post-Session estimates for the remainder of the forecast, resulting in an estimated **1,862** awards for FY 2019-20 and **2,022** awards for FY 2020-21.

<u>Benacquisto Scholarship Program</u>: The Conference estimated that the total number of awards would be higher than the previous estimate in all years of the forecast. The Conference adopted an estimate of **1,155** awards for FY 2018-19, an increase of 8 awards (0.7%) over the Post-Session estimate. For FY 2019-20, the Conference adopted **1,428** projected awards, an increase of 12 awards (0.8%) over the previous estimate. The Conference adopted **1,716** projected awards for FY 2020-21, an increase of 21 awards (1.2%) over the previous estimate.

<u>Florida Farmworker Scholarship Program</u>: The Conference maintained the Post-Session estimates of **3** projected awards for FY 2018-19 and the maximum allowable **50** awards for FY 2019-20 and FY 2020-21.

The estimates adopted on August 12th are shown in the following table. Across all programs, including Bright Futures early summer enrollments, the Conference anticipates **335,384** awards in FY 2018-19, **343,632** awards in FY 2019-20, and **347,842** awards in FY 2020-21. These award levels are lower than expected in the Post-Session estimates —by 12,424 in the just-concluded year, 11,084 in FY 2019-20, and 10,605 in FY 2020-21 with nearly all of the change related to Florida Student Assistance Grants.
