# Education Estimating Conference on Student Financial Aid 

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

## December 12, 2019

The Student Financial Aid Estimating Conference met on December 12, 2019, to revise estimates for FY 2019-20 through FY 2024-25 for student financial aid programs based on preliminary FY 2019-20 awards for Term 1.

Bright Futures Scholarships: For FY 2019-20, the Conference adopted 113,429 awards, an increase of 5,586 awards ( $5.2 \%$ ) over the previous estimate. The increase is related primarily to more renewal Florida Academic Scholars awards than were anticipated (an increase of 3,180 awards). This may be due to the larger than expected increase in the number and percentage of students qualifying for Florida Academic Scholars, when the award amount increased to $100 \%$ of tuition in FY 2017-18. For FY 202021, the Conference adopted 118,132 total awards, an increase of 7,662 awards ( $6.9 \%$ ) over the previous estimate. In addition, the Conference adopted estimates for early summer enrollments, including 9,376 for the 2020 summer term and 8,409 for the 2021 summer term. The Summer enrollments have been significantly stronger than expected.

Effective Access to Student Education (EASE) Grants: The Conference adopted an estimate of 40,219 awards for FY 2019-20, which is an increase of 450 awards ( $1.1 \%$ ) over the August estimate. The Conference adopted 41,063 awards for FY 2020-21, an increase of 406 awards ( $1.0 \%$ ) over the previous estimate.

Access to Better Learning and Education Grants (ABLE): The Conference adopted an estimate of 1,716 awards for FY 2019-20, a decrease of 18 awards ( $-1.0 \%$ ) from the August estimate. For FY 202021, the Conference adopted 1,769 awards, an increase of 46 awards ( $2.7 \%$ ) from the previous estimate.

Florida Student Assistance Grants (FSAG): The Conference adopted an estimate of 183,689 total awards in FY 2019-20, an increase of 316 awards $(0.2 \%)$ over the August estimate. For FY 2020-21, the Conference adopted an estimate of 183,942 awards, which is an increase of 320 awards ( $0.2 \%$ ) from the previous estimate.

Children/Spouses of Deceased/Disabled Veterans (CSDDV): The Conference adopted an estimate of 1,877 awards for FY 2019-20, which is an increase of 15 awards ( $0.8 \%$ ) over the August estimate. For FY 2020-21, the Conference adopted 2,032 projected awards, an increase of 10 awards ( $0.5 \%$ ) over the previous estimate.

Benacquisto Scholarship Program: The Conference adopted an estimate of 1,392 projected awards for FY 2019-20, a decrease of 35 awards ( $-2.5 \%$ ) over the August estimate. For FY 2020-21, the Conference adopted 1,623 projected awards, a decrease of 93 awards ( $-5.4 \%$ ) over the previous estimate.

Florida Farmworker Scholarship Program: The Conference adopted an estimate of 17 projected awards for FY 2019-20, a decrease of 33 awards ( $-66.0 \%$ ) over the August estimate. For FY 2020-21, the Conference adopted 42 projected awards, a decrease of 8 awards ( $-16.0 \%$ ) over the previous estimate.

The estimates adopted on December 12, 2019 are shown in the following table. Across all programs, including Bright Futures early summer enrollment, the Conference anticipates 351,716 awards in FY 2019-20 and 357,012 awards in FY 2020-21. These award levels are higher than expected in the August estimates -by 8,084 (2.4\%) in FY 2019-20 and 9,170 (2.6\%) in FY 2020-21 with nearly all of the change related to Bright Futures.
