Education Estimating Conference on Student Financial Aid EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

March 29, 2021

The Student Financial Aid Estimating Conference met on March 29, 2021, to revise estimates for FY 2020-21 through FY 2025-26 for student financial aid programs based on preliminary FY 2020-21 Fall and Spring Term awards. The new estimates reflect data through March 16, 2021, and are compared to the December 2020 Conference estimates. For some scholarship programs, the impact of the Coronavirus outbreak on institutional operations, as well as the persistent pandemic-induced economic contraction, is evident in preliminary FY 2020-21 data; however for others, the impact is compounded by possible offsetting behavioral effects.

<u>Bright Futures Scholarships</u>: The projected awards for FY 2020-21 total **119,848**, a decrease of 77 awards (or -0.1%) from the December estimate. In addition, the Conference adopted an estimate of **7,704** awards for early summer enrollments of high school graduates who were initially eligible for an award in the 2021-22 academic year, but who opt instead to enroll early in the 2021 summer term. For FY 2021-22, the Conference adopted **117,973** total awards, an increase of 1,014 awards (or 0.9%) over the previous estimate, as well as an estimated **7,732** early summer enrollments for the 2022 summer term. For FY 2022-23, the Conference adopted **115,366** total awards, and a total of **7,841** early summer enrollments for the 2023 summer term.

Effective Access to Student Education (EASE) Grants: The Conference estimated that the total number of awards would be slightly lower than the previous estimates in all years of the forecast due to the impact from the pandemic-related economic contraction. There were 39,533 projected awards for FY 2020-21, a decrease of 10 awards relative to the previous estimate. For FY 2021-22, the Conference adopted 40,430 total awards, a decrease of 293 awards (or -0.7%) relative to the previous estimate. The Conference also adopted 41,310 total awards in FY 2022-23, a decrease of 191 awards (-0.5%) relative to the previous estimate.

Access to Better Learning and Education (ABLE) Grants: The Conference continued to lower the estimated total number of awards from the previous estimate in all years of the forecast, for reasons similar to EASE. The Conference adopted an estimate of **1,526** awards for FY 2020-21, a decrease of 94 awards (or -5.8%) from the December estimate. For FY 2021-22, the Conference adopted **1,597** awards, a decrease of 33 awards (or -2.0%) from the previous estimate. The Conference also adopted **1,618** total awards for FY 2022-23, a decrease of 38 awards (or -2.3%) relative to the previous estimate.

<u>Florida Student Assistance Grants (FSAG)</u>: The Conference maintained the current estimates for this program, including an estimated **174,957** total awards in FY 2020-21, **174,943** total awards in FY 2021-22, and **174,931** awards in FY 2022-23.

<u>Children/Spouses of Deceased/Disabled Veterans (CSDDV)</u>: The Conference maintained the current estimates for this program, including an estimated **2,337** total awards in FY 2020-21, **2,641** total awards in FY 2021-22, and **2,898** awards in FY 2022-23.

<u>Benacquisto Scholarship Program</u>: The Conference adopted an estimate of **1,644** awards for FY 2020-21, an increase of 17 awards (or 1.0%) over the December estimate. For FY 2021-22, the Conference adopted **1,949** projected awards, an increase of 13 awards (or 0.7%) over the previous estimate. The Conference also adopted **2,183** projected awards for FY 2022-23, an increase of 43 awards (or 2.0%) over the previous estimate.

<u>Florida Farmworker Scholarship Program</u>: The Conference adopted an estimate of **44** awards for FY 2020-21, a decrease of **6** awards (or -12.0%) from the December estimate. The Conference estimated that the total number of awards would reach the maximum allowable 50 awards beginning in FY 2021-22 and maintain that level for the remainder of the forecast horizon.

The new estimates are shown in the following table. Across all programs, including Bright Futures early summer enrollments, the Conference anticipates **347,592** awards in FY 2020-21, **347,315** awards in FY 2021-22, and **346,197** awards in FY 2022-23. These award levels are higher than expected at the December Conference—by 241 or 0.1% in FY 2020-21; by 1,096 or 0.3% in FY 2021-22; and by 1,419 or 0.4% in FY 2022-23. The majority of the increase in awards is related to the forecast for the Bright Futures program.
