

**Voluntary Prekindergarten Estimating Conference
Executive Summary
December 12, 2013**

The Voluntary Prekindergarten Estimating Conference met on December 12, 2013 to review 2012-13 school year data; summer 2013 data; 2013-14 school year data reported through October 2013; and to adopt a forecast through 2016-17.

Enrollment data for program year 2012-13 indicates that 79.69% of eligible four-year olds participated in the VPK program. The participation rate is estimated to be 78.18% for the 2013-14 program year. Starting with the 2014-15 school year, program year enrollment is forecasted to grow based on the growth of Florida’s four-year-old population. Summer enrollment is assumed to remain at 2013 levels.

SISP data were incorporated as follows:

- Reported data for the 2012-13 school year and summer 2013 were applied to their respective periods.
- 2013-14 school year was estimated based on year-to-date activity.
- “SISP Only” refers to SISP children who either:
 - Came directly into SISP, or
 - Had SISP participation into another fiscal year.
- “SISP Only” enrollment will be held constant in the forecast to the levels seen in the 2013 summer and the estimate for 2013-14 school year.
- Starting with the 2013-14 school year each “SISP Only” student is assumed to earn 1.0 FTE.

The estimates and forecasts, starting with school year 2013-14, utilize the most recent ratio of FTE to enrollment (2012-13 school year and 2013 summer). The changes in enrollment and FTE are attributable to the findings from the 2013-14 school year data reported through October 2013, the reported SISP data, revised forecasts of the four-year-old population, and new FTE to enrollment ratios. In addition, forecasted growth rates are based on four-year-old population growth rather than a participation rate target. The resulting participation rates are 78.2% in Fiscal Year 2014-15 and 2015-16, and 78.3% in 2016-17.

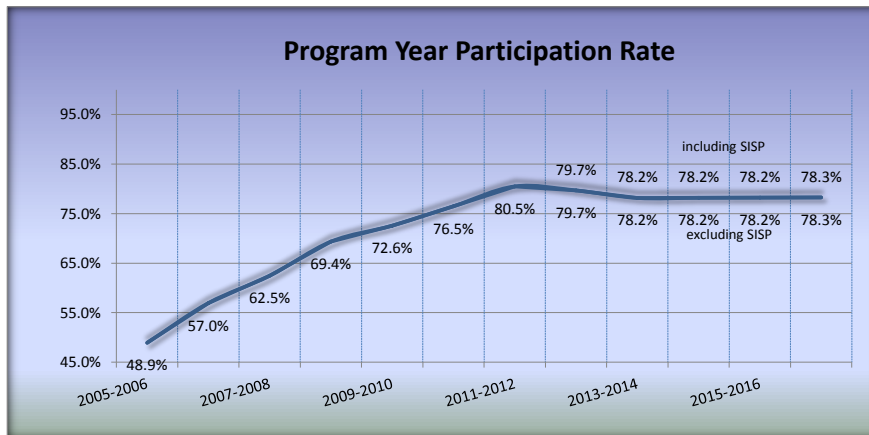

Participation Rates in Selected States

The National Institute for Early Education Research (NIEER), a unit of Rutgers University, has published annual state pre-K reports for the last decade. *The State of Preschool 2012*, for the 2011-2012 school year, includes detailed profiles on pre-kindergarten programs and tracks funding, access, and policies in each state.

The ten states included in this table have the highest percent of 4-year-olds enrolled in state pre-K in 2011-2012. They offer Universal pre-K and the eligibility for most is based solely on age. The table also indicates which states have a funding cap for their pre-K program. Florida, West Virginia and Texas do not have a funding cap.

In the 2011-12 school year, Florida, Oklahoma and Vermont continued to serve the most 4-year-olds. Georgia moved from fourth to sixth in the ranking, and South Carolina replaced Arizona as the tenth state.

Participation rates are calculated from 4-year-olds enrollment numbers published by each state and population of 4-year-olds from the Census Bureau's datasets. Enrollment numbers for the 2012-2013 school year were gathered from each state. *The State of Preschool 2013* will be published in April 2014.
