Revenue Estimating Conference Indian Gaming Revenues Executive Summary August 11, 2021

The Revenue Estimating Conference met on August 11, 2021, to adopt new estimates for Indian Gaming revenues. Prior to this Conference, no revenue sharing dollars had been expected within the State's forecast horizon. After making its April 2019 payment, the Tribe had ceased all revenue sharing with the State associated with the 2010 Compact.

The Governor and the Seminole Tribe of Florida signed a new Compact on April 23, 2021, with an amendment on May 17, 2021. It was subsequently ratified by the Legislature in Special Session by CS/SB 2-A, which was approved by the Governor on May 25, 2021. As required by law, a copy of the executed compact and the ratifying act was subsequently submitted to the United States Secretary of the Interior for her review and approval. The State was formally notified that the Secretary of the Interior had taken no action to approve or disapprove the Compact before August 5, 2021, the 45th day of its submission, which made it effective upon the publication of notice in the Federal Register on August 11th. As a result, the Compact is now considered to have been approved by operation of law to the extent that it complies with IGRA and existing Federal law.

The August approval date triggers the first revenue sharing cycle to begin on September 1, 2021. The new forecast is developed from the application of four discrete revenue sharing brackets and a schedule of guaranteed minimum payments that apply to the first five revenue sharing cycles. The guarantees are:

- At least \$400 million for any revenue sharing cycle during the first five years of the Compact, however, this portion of the guarantee is not projected to be applicable;
- At least \$1.5 billion by the end of the third revenue sharing cycle with the payment due within 30 calendar days after the end of the third cycle; and
- At least \$2.5 billion by the end of the fifth revenue sharing cycle with the payment due within 30 calendar days after the end of the fifth cycle.

The table below shows the conversion of the funds expected during each revenue sharing cycle to cash which is inclusive of the applicable guarantees. All funds will benefit General Revenue; the local distributions will be treated separately on the General Revenue Financial Outlook Statement.
