

Early Learning Programs Estimating Conference
School Readiness Program
Executive Summary
August 7, 2025

The Early Learning Programs Estimating Conference met on August 7, 2025, to adopt a new School Readiness Program forecast through FY 2030-31. The forecast incorporates changes contained within Ch. 2025-110, L.O.F.; FY 2024-25 FTE data through June 2025; updated demographic data reflecting the latest Demographic Estimating Conference results; the latest 5-year American Community Survey (2019-2023) data; and an FTE forecast from the April 2025 PreK-12 Education Estimating Conference.

Children in eligible low-income households can participate in the program's range of services from birth through the age of 12.¹ The FTE are linked to "Care Level" (Infant, Toddler, 2 Year Old, Preschool 3, Preschool 4, Preschool 5, and School Age) with three different forecasting methodologies tailored to those levels of care. To forecast Infant FTE, average historical rates of Infant FTE relative to births are applied to the Demographic Estimating Conference birth series. Historical progression trends from each of the Care Levels between Infant and Preschool 5 are used to forecast cohorts moving through these respective levels. Finally, average historical rates of School Age FTE relative to non-scholarship Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP) FTE are applied to the Education Estimating Conference non-scholarship FTE forecast series to produce the School Age FTE forecast.

Ch. 2025-110, L.O.F, Sections 22 and 26 were both considered in the development of the conference product. First, Section 22 modifies the definition of economically disadvantaged, from "a family income that does not exceed 150 percent of the federal poverty level..." to "a family income that does not exceed 55 percent of the state median income...". This affects the initial eligible population starting October 1, 2025. Secondly, to accommodate the revisions specified in Section 26, the conference product was expanded to include both an extension of the population forecast by care level for the entire forecast horizon and detailed tables of population by county and care level by fiscal year. In addition, the analysis considered eligible population by county relative to the enrollment forecast."

Enrollment data reported through June for FY 2024-25 suggests a revised total of 113,062.52 FTE, a decrease of 2,355.71 relative to the prior forecast and an increase 1,647.70 (1.5%) over FY 2023-24. Just two counties accounted for over one-half of this loss to the estimate: Miami-Dade County had 38.3% of the loss, and Orange County had 17.5%. Forecasted growth over the prior year ranges from a high of 1,152.78 (1.0%) in FY 2029-30 to a decline of -40.34 (essentially zero percent) in FY 2028-29. The final year of the forecast, FY 2030-31, is expected to reach 115,870.32 FTE.

¹ The criteria for the traditional School Readiness program includes:

- Gross income must be at or below 150 percent of the FPL by care level through September 30, 2025 and at or below 55% SMI starting October 1, 2025; and at or below 85 percent of the State Median Income (SMI) for continued eligibility;
- Parent(s)/guardian(s) must work or participate in an educational activity such as attending college or trade school at least 20 hours per week; and,
- Families must pay a copayment for child care based on income and family size.
- The School Readiness Match (SRMT) Program extends services to low-income families up to 85 percent of the SMI, including those families who were initially above 150 percent of the FPL.
