1) Section 2 of CS/HB 3 amends s. 145.071, F.S., to increase the base salaries of county sheriffs by \$5,000 across all population groups, effective July 1, 2022. When the \$5,000 base salary increase is multiplied through the Chapter 145, F.S., salary computation formula, the FY 2021-22 salaries of all county sheriffs increase by \$23,595. The figures in this table assume that county sheriffs' salaries are determined by the statutory salary formula.

2) CS/HB 3 was approved by the Governor on April 1, 2022, and codified as Chapter 2022-23, L.O.F.
