Revenue Estimating Conference Indian Gaming Revenues February 12, 2013 Executive Summary

The Revenue Estimating Conference on Indian Gaming revenues met on February 12, 2013 and adopted updated estimates for revenues from Indian Gaming operations for fiscal years 2012-13 through 2017-18.

The estimates of total receipts were unchanged from the November 2012 forecast for fiscal years 2012-13 through 2014-15. Generally, the Conference used growth rates derived from pari-mutuel slots activity in Florida to estimate the Net Win for Tribal facilities. Due to the slowdown expected in pari-mutuel slots activity, the Conference anticipated that Tribal Net Win will not exceed the amount necessary to generate the Guaranteed Minimum Payment through fiscal year 2014-15—meaning a true-up Revenue Share payment is no longer expected in fiscal year 2015-16. As a result of the lower underlying forecast and the loss of the true-up payment, the total distribution to General Revenue in 2015-16 is expected to be only \$109.5 million which is \$6.2 million less than the previous estimate. Finally, the Conference estimated that General Revenue will receive \$105.3 million in 2016-17 and \$107.4 million in 2017-18.
