

## **PCB JDC 18-03 – Public Safety**

This bill amends s. 800.03, F.S., adding a **Level 3, 3<sup>rd</sup> degree felony** for a person with a prior conviction for exposure of sexual organs, a 1<sup>st</sup> degree misdemeanor, who commits a second or subsequent violation.

Per FDLE, in FY 16-17, 768 people were arrested for exposure of sexual organs, with 244 guilty/convicted and 59 having adjudication withheld. For repeat offenders, 130 were arrested, with 36 guilty/convicted and 1 having adjudication withheld.

In FY 16-17, the incarceration rate for a Level 3, 3<sup>rd</sup> degree felony was 10.9%.

### **CONFERENCE ADOPTED ESTIMATE: Positive Insignificant**

This bill also amends s. 948.06, F.S., creating a statewide alternative sanctioning program, with an explanation for when alternative sanctions would apply for different technical violators.

Per DOC, in FY 16-17, 5,443 technical violators were sentenced to prison.
