## CS/HB 7057 – Corrections (Similar CS/SB 7046)

This bill amends s. 330.41, F.S., adding the following to the definition of critical infrastructure facility: state correctional institutions, private correctional facilities, secure detention centers/facilities, nonsecure residential facilities, high-risk residential facilities, maximum-risk residential facilities, and county detention facilities. With these additions, such facilities are now included as areas where a person may not knowingly or willfully operate a drone over, allow a drone to make contact with, or allow a drone to come within a distance which is close enough to interfere with the operations of or cause a disturbance to the facility. Penalties for these activities remain 2<sup>nd</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup> degree misdemeanors. This bill also amends s. 943.13, F.S., decreasing the age requirement for employment as a correctional officer from 19 to 18, which could impact the 2<sup>nd</sup> degree misdemeanor for false official statements.

Per FDLE, in FY 17-18, there have been no arrests for misdemeanors associated with s. 330.41, F.S.; this law went into effect on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017. However, one arrest was recorded in December 2018, but there have been no convictions or adjudications withheld in that time period. While a small number of arrests were recorded for s. 837.06, F.S., it is not known if any of these were connected to s. 943.13, F.S.
