

SB 236 – Pretrial Detention

This bill amends s. 907.041, F.S., adding the following: “a defendant charged with a dangerous crime who has been previously convicted of such a crime poses a threat of harm to the community and that the factual circumstances of such crimes indicate a disregard for the safety of the community. The court shall order pretrial detention if the court finds that there is a substantial probability that a defendant charged with a dangerous crime committed such a crime and if the court finds that there are no conditions of release reasonably sufficient to protect the community from the risk of physical harm to persons.”
