

## **Demographic Estimating Conference**

### **Executive Summary**

The Demographic Estimating Conference met on February 18, 2009 to establish a population forecast based on an April 1, 2008 population estimate and recent demographic-related data.

In the past, Florida's population growth has been mostly driven by positive net migration (more people permanently moving into the state than leaving). Net migration is estimated to have fallen to record low levels with the state experiencing more outmigration than immigration during much of 2008. Florida is expected to continue to experience an outflow of residents through the third quarter of 2009 followed by low levels of net migration through mid-2011. While there was little change to natural increase (births minus deaths), it is projected to exceed net migration through the second quarter of 2011. This is largely due to current economic conditions, including weakened housing markets and a national economic contraction, making it more difficult for people to relocate to the state.

The final population estimate for April 1, 2008 of 18,807,219 was very close to the preliminary estimate of 18,807,102. Florida's April 1, 2009 population is expected to remain constant at the April 1, 2008 level. The weaker national outlook coupled with current economic conditions in the state, led the conference to reduce the forecast for population growth over the next few years. Population growth is forecast to be less than one percent over the next three years, 0.39%, 0.38, 0.83% for the years ending April 1, 2010, 2011, and 2012, respectively. Stronger population growth is expected as the economy improves with growth rates of 1.48% (283,580 net new residents) and 1.67% (324,120 net new residents) between April 1, 2012 to April 1, 2013 and April 1, 2013 to April 1, 2014, respectively.

Between April 1, 2008 and April 1, 2019, population growth is expected to average 213,031 net new residents per year, representing a compound growth rate of 1.07% over this 11-year time horizon. These increases are analogous to adding a city the size of Hialeah every year. By April 1, 2015 Florida's population is expected to have broken the 20-million mark at 20,055,865 and is forecast to be approaching the 24-million mark with 23,979.030 residents on April 1, 2030.
