(2) If all counties were to implement the increased exemption, the statewide cost in the fifth year would be approximately \$10.7 million, assuming no off-setting changes in millage rates by local governments.

(3) If the electorate approves the amendment, the statewide impact in 2009-10 would be -\$2.2 billion, assuming no off-setting changes in millage rates by local governments.

(4) Should the electorate approve the amendment, the tax base statewide would be affected as follows: 2008-09 -\$23,714,209,869, 2009-10 -\$49,654,532,809, 2010-11 -\$76,899,391,350, 2011-12 -\$105,767,494,394, 2012-13 -\$136,647,412,012.

Assuming no changes in millage rates, the statewide tax loss would be 2008-09 \$464,798,513, 2009-10 \$973,228,843, 2010-11 \$1,507,228,070, 2011-12 \$2,073,042,890, 2012-13 \$2,678,289,277.

(5) If the electorate approves the amendment, the statewide impact would be: 2008-09 -\$1,793.3m, 2009-10 -\$3,741.9m, 2010-11 -\$5,828.2 m, 2011-12 -\$8,068.0, and 2012-13 -\$10,489.9 m, assuming

no off-setting changes in millage rates by local governments.

(6) If the electorate approves the amendment and the legislature enact general law exempting currently taxed leasehold property, the statewide impact from this provision alone would be a reduction in taxable value of \$1.5 billion.

(7) Should this language be included with the language in SB962, the impact of this language would be reduced by 50%.

Assuming no changes in millage rates, the statewide tax loss would be 2008-09 \$393,911,970, 2009-10 \$825,583,099, 2010-11 \$1,274,153,004, 2011-12 \$1,749,947,803, 2012-13 \$2,255,239,275.

(22) Should the electorate approve the amendment, the conference estimates that the loss to the tax roll in 2008-09 would be \$87.8 million and in 2009-10 would be \$94.0 million ,

which would result in a statewide tax loss of \$1.8 million in 2008-09 and \$1.9 million in 2009-10, assuming no change in local millage rates.

(23) Should all cities and counties choose to provide the exemption, the tax base statewide would be reduced by \$479 million in 2007-08, with a resulting tax loss of \$5.4 million, assuming no adjustments in millage rates.
