

## **Social Services Estimating Conference**

### **Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Assistance Payments**

#### Executive Summary

The Social Services Estimating Conference convened on October 1 to revisit the estimates for the current fiscal year and adopt a new forecast for FY 2005-06.

The estimate for the current year has been reduced slightly from the previous estimate done last January, which was used for the FY 2004-05 appropriation. Total expenditures for assistance payments are estimated to be less than the appropriated amount by \$5.8 million. Both the number of persons receiving grant payments and the average grant amount are expected to be lower than the previous forecast.

For FY 2005-06, the expenditure forecast is less than the current year appropriation by \$4.4 million, coming in at \$225.8 million. The 2005-06 forecast is basically unchanged from FY 2004-05, as slightly higher grant payments are offset by fewer recipients.

Discussion at the conference centered on a change in the method of recording cases for the relative caregiver recipient cohort. This change, basically a definitional change, increases caseloads over the next year, but has little impact on cost because the number of persons represented by the caseload measure is not affected. Additional discussion centered on the possibility of an impact on costs due to the recent hurricanes. The transient nature of the dislocation produced by the storms was thought to be too short to cause any measurable uptick in caseloads. By the time unemployment benefits and other forms of government assistance would be exhausted, business activity would have resumed sufficiently to provide ample employment opportunity and thus mitigate any impact on the TANF program.
