

**Voluntary Prekindergarten Estimating Conference**  
**Executive Summary**  
**March 7, 2011**

The Voluntary Prekindergarten Estimating Conference reviewed 2009-10 and 2010-11 school year and 2010 summer data through January 31, 2011, and revised population estimates. Enrollment and full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollment data for program year and fiscal year 2009-10 is now considered final. The conference adopted new enrollment forecasts for the Voluntary Prekindergarten Program (VPK) for 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14, and 2014-15. Enrollment for FY 2010-11 remained below the appropriated level.

For the 2010-11 program year, it is estimated that 71.09% of eligible four year olds will participate in the VPK program. The participation rate is anticipated to increase to 73.70% for the 2011-12 program year and reach 75% by the 2012-13 program year.

The assumptions for the forecasts through 2014-15 are:

- By 2012-13, 75% of the eligible 4-year olds will be participating in the program. The program will continue at the 75% participation level.
- Enrollment in the summer program is expected to remain at 8,606, the same as summer 2010 enrollment, throughout the forecast time period. Round-up calculations for summers 2011 through 2015 are held constant at 2010 levels.

The estimates and forecasts, starting with school year 2010-11, utilize the most recent ratio of enrollment to FTE (2009-10 school year and 2010 summer). The revised fiscal year FTEs are as follows:



FTE calculation is based on the number of hours paid divided by 540 or 300 depending on the child's program (either 540 for the School Year program or 300 for the summer program).
Participation Rate	Program Year enrollment divided by the estimated/forecasted October 1, population of 4-year olds.
Program Year	Includes the VPK School Year and Summer Programs based on eligibility as determined by date of birth.
Public School Round-up	The public school FTE enrollment round-up refers to adding enrollment to public school FTE enrollment if the level of enrollment is not a multiple of 12 for summer 2009 and beyond and a multiple of 10 for summers 2007 and 2008.
School Year	540 hour VPK Program that runs from July/August (varies by county) until May/June.
Summer	300 hour VPK Program that runs from May/June to July/August.
