

Voluntary Prekindergarten Estimating Conference
Executive Summary
September 28, 2011

The Voluntary Prekindergarten Estimating Conference met on September 28, 2011 to review 2010-11 school year and 2011 summer data through August 31, 2011. Population projections based on the 2010 Census and the impact on participation rates were also discussed. Based on this information and actual experience over the past few months, the conference adopted new enrollment forecasts for the Voluntary Prekindergarten Program (VPK) for 2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14, and 2014-15.

Enrollment and full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollment data for program year and Fiscal Year 2010-11 are preliminary. For the 2010-11 program year, it is estimated that 76.21% of eligible four year olds participated in the VPK program. The participation rate is anticipated to increase to 78.71% for the 2011-12 program year and reach 80% by the 2012-13 program year.

The assumptions for the forecasts through 2014-15 are:

- By 2012-13, 80% of the eligible 4-year olds will be participating in the program. The program will continue at the 80% participation level.
- Enrollment in the summer program is expected to remain at 8,275, the same as summer 2011 enrollment, throughout the forecast time period. Round-up calculations for summers 2012 through 2015 are held constant at 2011 levels.

The estimates and forecasts, starting with school year 2011-12, utilize the most recent ratio of enrollment to FTE (2010-11 school year and 2011 summer). The revised fiscal year FTEs are shown immediately below. The lowering of the FTE for fiscal years 2012-13 through 2014-15 was caused by a combination of a lower estimate for the base year of 2011-12 and the lower estimate of the 4-year old population arising from the 2010 census results.


