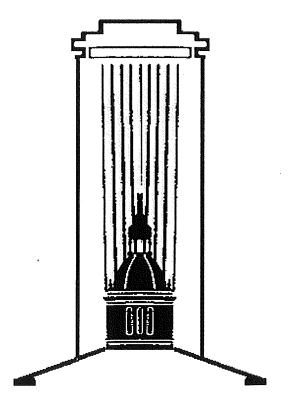

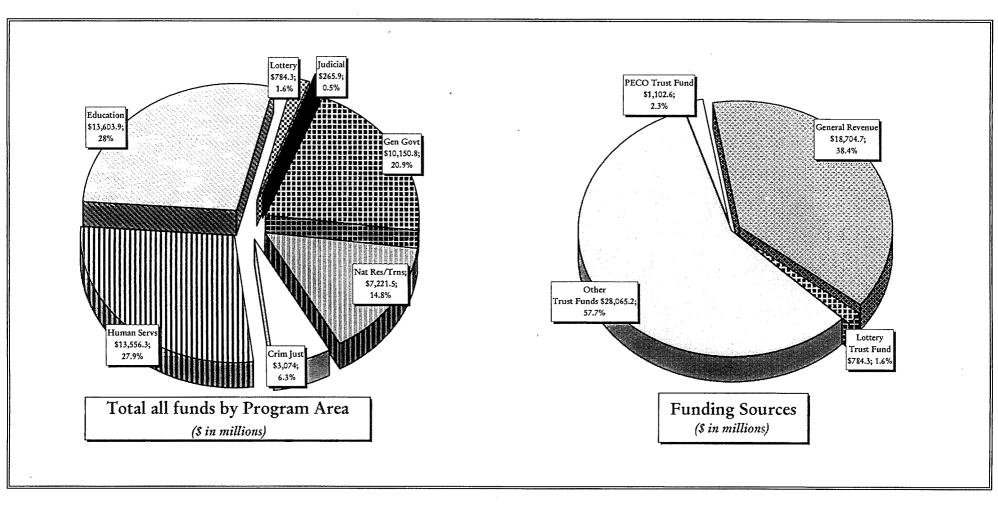
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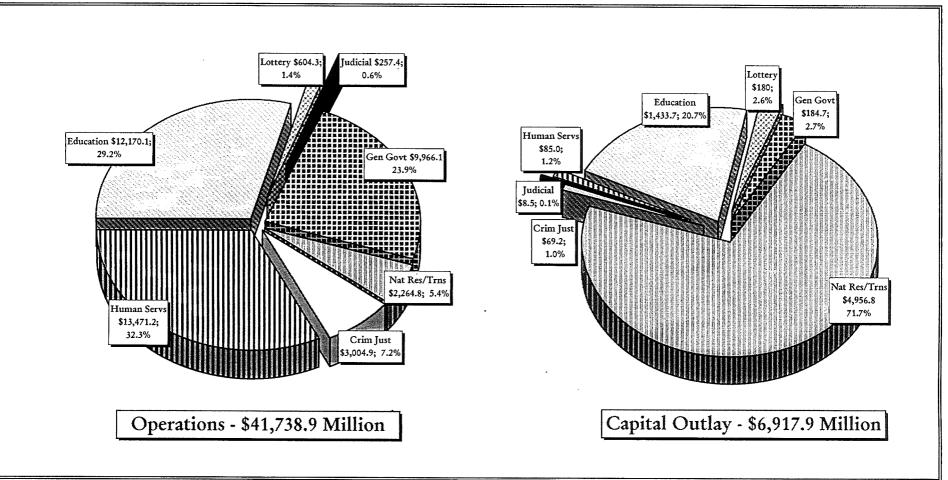

Appropriations & Fund Sources For Fiscal Year 1999-2000 \$48.7 Billion



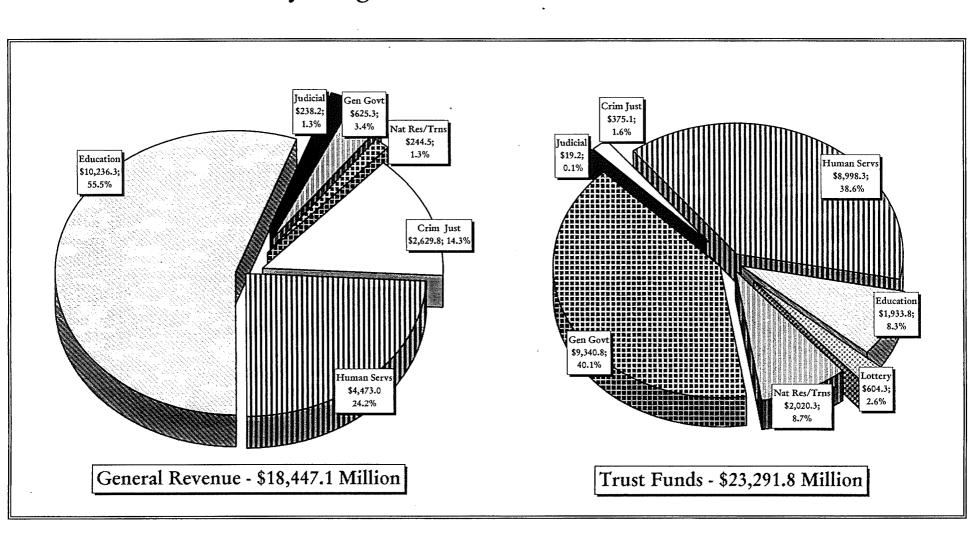
Operations & Capital Outlay Distribution For Fiscal Year 1999-2000 By Program Area - \$48.7 Billion



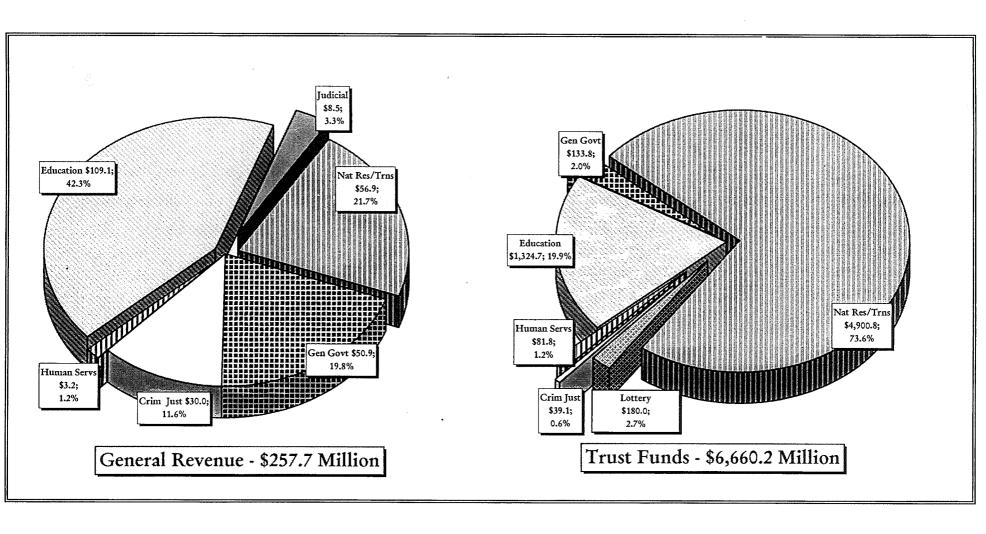

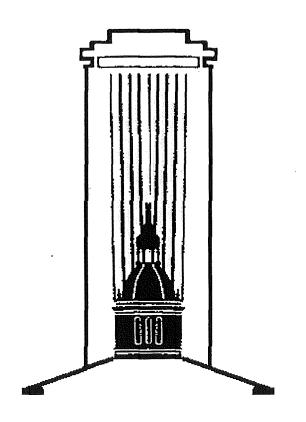
For Fiscal Year 1999-2000

Capital Outlay & Debt Service For Fiscal Year 1999-2000 By Program Area - \$6.9 Billion

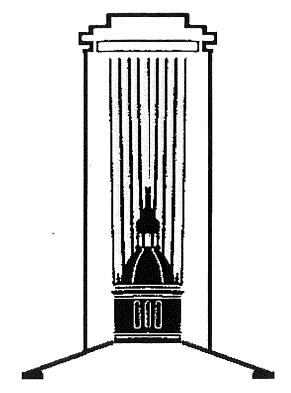

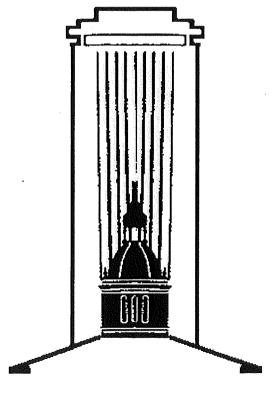
